

# Super Simple Shawl Pattern

## Materials

Yarn: 10 -16 Ozs yarn of choice.  
 I have used Red Hearts worsted weight and Joann's Rainbow Boucle, and both worked up well.  
 I skein of novelty yarn such as Patons. Allure, Bernats Fun Fur prints, or the like, in coordinating color.  
 Hook: Size K

## Shawl

**Row 1** Ch 2 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook leaving 1 lp on hook for each stitch 3 lps on hook, yo and draw through all the lps, (cluster made) \*ch 2, 3 dc in the same st as 1st cluster, leaving 1 lp on hook for each stitch, 4 lps on hook, yo and draw through all the lps,\* (cluster made) repeat from \* to \* till you have 5 clusters total. ch 3 turn,

**Row 2** sc in ch 2 lp, ch 2, sc in same lp, \* ch 3 sc in next ch 2 lp, ch 2, sc in same lp,\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, ch 3, sc in top of cluster. ch 5 turn,

**Row 3** 2 dc in ch 3 lp ch 2, 2 dc in same lp, 2 dc in next ch 3 lp ch 2, 2 dc in same lp, 2 dc in next ch 3 lp ( ch 2, 2 dc in same lp,) 2 times,ch 2 , 2 dc in same lp, {2 dc in next ch 3 lp ch 2, 2 dc in same lp,} 2 times, ch 1 tr in same lp, ch 5 turn,

**Row 4** 1 dc in ch 1 sp, \* dc, ch 3, dc, in ch 2 lp,in \* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, ending with dc, ch 2, tr in sp created by the ch 5 turn,of previous row, ch 5 turn,

**Row 5** 2 dc in ch 2 lp ch 2, 2 dc in same lp, \* 2 dc in next ch 3 lp ch 2, 2 dc in same lp,\* repeat from \* to \* to center v st, 2 dc in next ch 3 lp ( ch 2, 2 dc in same lp,) 2 times,ch 2 , 2 dc in same lp, \*\* 2 dc in next ch 3 lp ch 2, 2 dc in same lp \*\* repeat from \*\* to \*\* to end of row, ending with ch 1 tr in same lp, ch 5 turn,

**Row 6 - On** repeat rows 4 and 5 till desired size. Ending with a Row 4 repeat.

## Trims and edgings.

### Trim Number 1

For the Black shawl I used Fun Fur Prints,

Attach yarn to center back of Shawl. ch 1 sc in same space. \*ch 2, sc in next sp created by ch 5 or tr, ch 2, sc in same sp, \* Repeat from \* to \* to corner of shawl, (ch 2, sc in same sp,) 2 times in corner st.

Working down the side, \*\*ch 2, sc in ch 3 sp, ch 2, sc in same sp, ch 2, sc in st between v st, \*\* Repeat from \*\* to \*\* to center point, (ch 2, sc in same sp,) 5 times in center point. \*\*ch 2, sc in ch 3 sp, ch 2, sc in same sp, ch 2, sc in st between v st, \*\* Repeat from \*\* to \*\* to corner of shawl, (ch 2, sc in same sp,) 2 times in corner st. Working across the top edge again \*ch 2, sc in next sp created by ch 5 or tr, ch 2, sc in same sp, \* Repeat from \* to \* to center of the shawl,

To add trim on the shawl count out ten rows from center, With right side facing you attach yarn to edge of shawl \*ch 3, sc in sp between shell, ch 3 sc center st of shell, \* Repeat from \* to \* to center point of shawl, (ch 3 sc center st of shell,) 3 times in center point. \*ch 3, sc in sp between shell, ch 3 sc center st of shell, \* Repeat from \* to \* to the next edge, Sl st into edging and end off. weave ends in,

(Count down 10 more rows and repeat. ) 2 times. You may find you want to change the number of rows between trim to balance out your trim. That will depend on the number of rows you did to complete your shawl.

### **Trim number 2**

For Rainbow Boucle Shawl,

Attach yarn to center back of Shawl. ch 1 sc in same space. \* 3 sc, in sp created by ch 5, or tr on shawl,\*  
\* repeat from \* to \* to corner of shawl, 5 sc in corner st, \*\* 1sc, 1 dc, 1 sc, in ch 3 sp,\*\* repeat from \*\* to \*\*  
to center point, (1sc, 1 dc, 1 sc, ) 5 times in center point. \*\* 1sc, 1 dc, 1 sc, in ch 3 sp,\*\* repeat from \*\* to  
\*\* to corner of shawl, 5 sc in corner st, \* 3 sc, in sp created by ch 5, or tr on shawl,\* \* repeat from \* to \* to  
center of shawl, sl st into 1st sc, end off, weave ends in.

**Hint** It may help you to keep track of your increase in the center if you mark it with a safety pin or other marker. Very easy to get crocheting along and forget to increase. You do not need to move the marker every row, just every 4th or 5th row would allow you to see where you are in your repetitions.



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
