

Swan Bookmarker Pattern

Bookmarker measures 9 inches

Materials

Thread Size 10 cotton thread,

Hook Size 7 or 1.65mm

Misc. A size I hook and a steel crochet hook any size.

(used to create the rings)

Padding cord = Small amount of thread cut separate from the ball of thread. About 3 foot should give you plenty.

Abbreviations

Ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

cl = cluster stitch

sk = skip

lp = loop

rnd = round

rep = repeat

* Repeat from as indicated

sl st = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet

tr = treble crochet

p = picot

st = stitch

sp = space

inc = increase

() = repeat between as indicated

Special Stitches

pc ring = **Padding cord ring** this ring is made by wrapping your padding cord around the **non working** end of a crochet hook. Normally 8-10 times is sufficient. cut off excess thread, leaving about 1 inch tail Gently slide off and insert hook with your working thread into ring draw thread through and sc in ring. follow instructions for the number of sc in ring. (**Hint**) do not wrap it to tightly or you will have trouble sliding it off the hook and retaining its shape. Making these rings takes a little practice but gets easier as you go along.

Swan Bookmarker

To begin the swan you will wrap the cut piece of thread around the size I crochet hook as described in the pc ring. 12 wraps, cut off excess (3 sc in ring, ch 4,) 5 times, 3 sc in ring, ch 2, dc in 1st sc of ring.

Rnd 1 ch 1 sc in top of same lp, *ch 4, sc in next lp* repeat from * to * around.

Rnd 2 sl st into ch 4 lp, ch 1, 5 sc in lp, 5 sc in each lp around, sl st into 1st sc in ring, Do not turn ch 8, Now you will make another smaller pc ring using the non working end of the steel crochet hook, (8 wraps) insert hook with thread at the end of your ch 8, into ring and work 5 sc into ring, ch 2 sl st into next sc on main body, ch 2, 3 sc into sm pc ring, do not join, 14 hdc over ch 8 ch, sc in next sc on main body, sc in next sc, ch 1, sl st into 3rd hdc up neck, ch 1 sc in next sc, (ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next sc,) 3 times, ch 2, dc in next sc, tr in next sc, ch 4 p in top of tr, ch 3, sl st in next sc, sl st around to center bottom of the swans body,

Next Step Ch 65, turn sc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch up to the swans body sl st into next sc, ch 3 turn, * sc in next 2 sc, ch 3, * repeat from * to * to end of bookmark, sc in sp created by turning, Ch 3 counts as 1 tr, 3 more tr working off 2 lps 2 times on each st, holding remaining lp on hook till all stitches are done 5 lps on hook, { 4 lps on 1st cl } yo and draw through all 5 loops (4 tr cluster st made) ch 4 p in top of cluster st. ch 3 sl into sp at base of cluster, * 2sc in next 2 back lps of ch st ch 3 * repeat from * to * to where bookmark joins body, sl st into next sc and end off, Weave in ends and block
